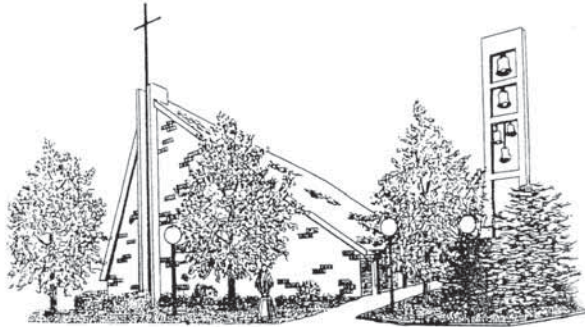

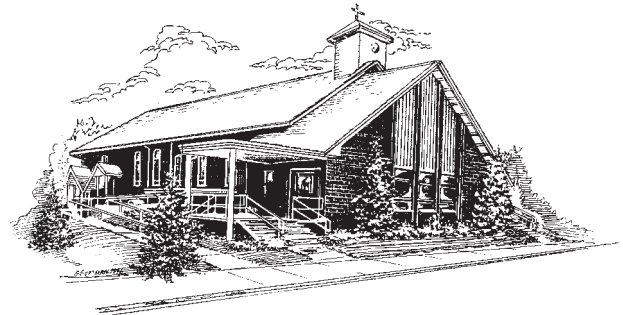

PASTOR'S CORNER

The Pope in 1209 had a dream that Francis of Assisi would help him rebuild a Church that was in disarray. That event came after the vision that Francis had where Christ on a cross told him to rebuild the church. The Franciscan vision has re-energized us in so many ways. It points us back to the simplicity of the Gospel, to a life of service and adoration of the Lord. Francis was not concerned about Canon Law, ornate vestments, ecclesiastical titles or awards. Instead, he wanted us to become authentic witnesses of Christ's practical love. He had no discomfort with selling Church properties if that would assist the poor. In the process of spreading the good news, he enlisted women who were close to him. They broadened his thought and softened his outreach. Later, he travelled to Egypt to meet and understand Muslims. He returned with a new respect for their devotion. Finally, he showed his gratitude to the Creator by caring for nature in all its forms. Water and animals were all gifts to be treasured as on-loan from God. His feast is today and to honor that, Pope Francis will issue a new encyclical.

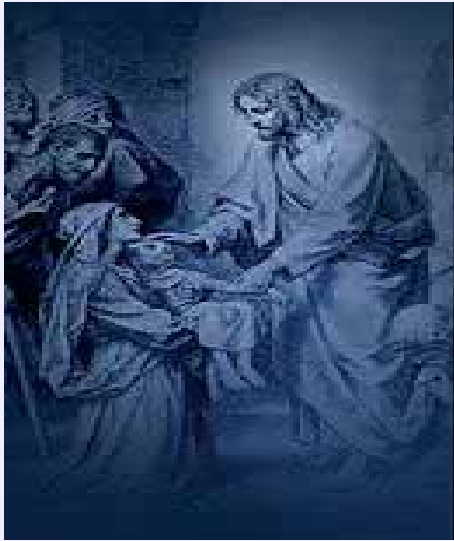
